EOL determination includes an assessment of the reliability, capacity and ability to maintain and repair. One or more of these critical characteristics has been compromised and requires owner action if the equipment or system is needed beyond the near term.

Maintenance and repair activities will soon or have already been reduced or eliminated because of the equipment and system condition or maintainability. Once returned to normal condition, please notify me. We will evaluate the condition and return it to our maintenance roster if applicable.
